The following students are CCCCs 2009 fall semester award recipients:



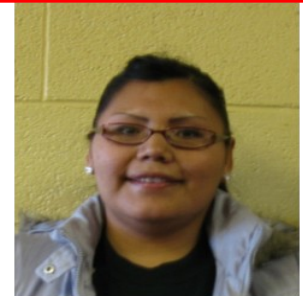

One of the students quoted, 'through the motivational speaker we learned how to be more successful with our business and to be more people orientated'.

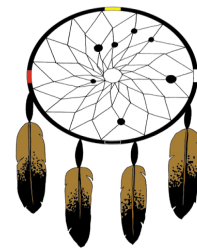
Another student stated, 'we should have more trips, more students, over-all I love it, it was great'.
