Applications are now being accepted for the Phylicie and Duane Houk Scholarship. Their daughter, Marcia Bearor, managed the Fort Totten Trail Inn located on Fort Totten. The five months living there in the summer of 2018 she learned to love the surroundings and culture and wanted to give back to the community. She knew how important education was to her parents so in their honor Marcia has established this scholarship in their name.

All ECE and Pre-Nursing students registered for at least a half-time course load at CCCC will be eligible for the semester scholarship. The scholarship award amount is \$500 with the preference to be given to students who: (1) have successfully completed at least one semester of coursework; (2) are pursuing two-year degree in teaching or nursing, (3) GPA of 2.5 or higher and (4) is Native American. Applicants must submit an application and one-page essay explaining their educational and career goals any volunteer work you have done. Applications are also available in the Financial Aid Office at CCCC.
