Paul Yankton Jr. was a business man in our community for over 30 years operating Paul's Grocery, Paul's Gas and Oil and Laundry Mat. He was an avid sports fan who followed our Four Winds Indians Basketball teams wherever they went. In his early years he enjoyed bowling, playing amateur basketball and softball. He was a big Minnesota Twins and Vikings fan. He would always watch or listen to all their games. The biggest and most important part of his life was raising his children and grandchildren. He was also involved in the education of our community, as he was a member of TATE TOPA Tribal School, Ft. Totten District #30 school boards and the Chairman of Cankdeska Cikana Community College Board of Regents for over 30 years. He dedicated his life to ensuring that education was a staple of our community.

Applications are now being accepted for Paul Yankton Memorial Scholarships. All students registered for at least a half-time course load at CCCC will be eligible for the scholarship. Preference will be given to students who: (1) are Native American (2) have unmet financial need; (3) have successfully completed at least one semester of coursework or otherwise demonstrated commitment to their coursework; (4) Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or Higher; and (5) are pursuing two-year degree programs. Applicants must complete an application and one-page essay explaining their educational and career goals and how this scholarship will help them achieve those goals.
