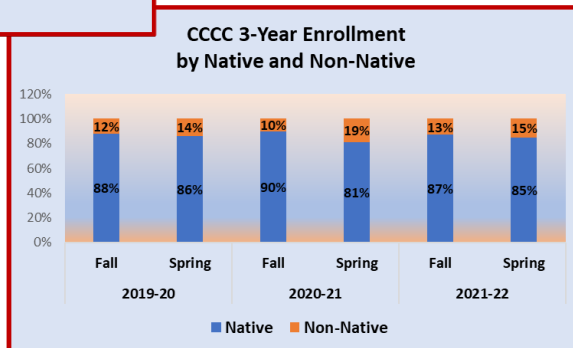
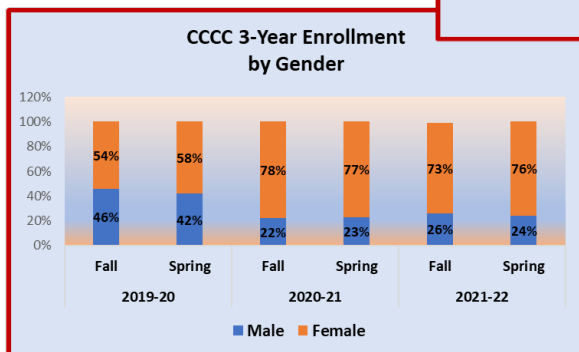
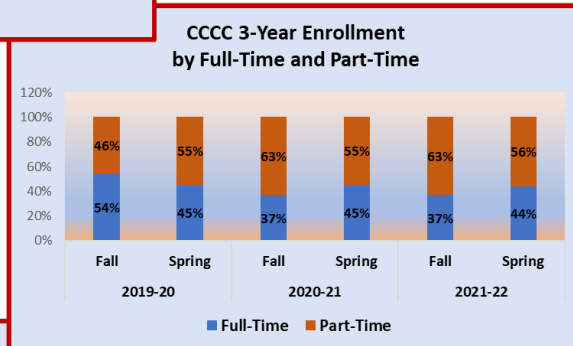
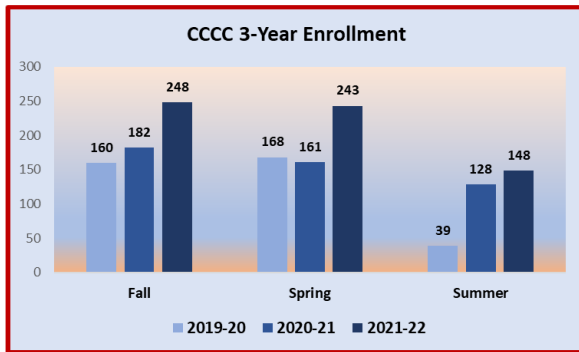
## Mission Statement

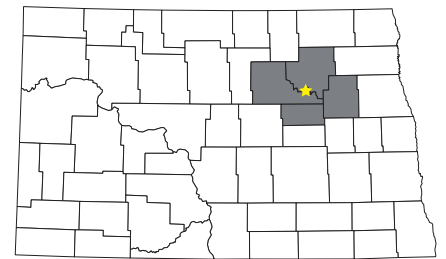
## Cankdeska Cikana Community College (CCCC)

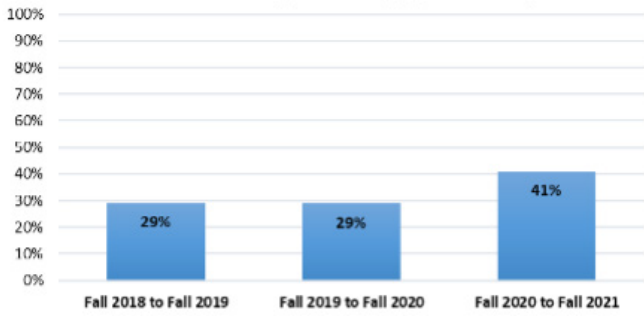

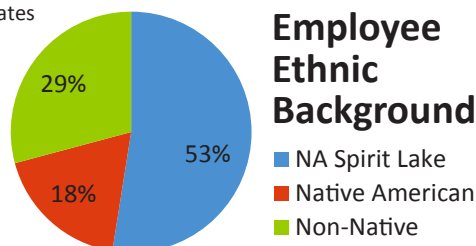
