Program Highlights 2023-24

1. I received my Master's Degree in Fine Arts from UND in May of 2023.

2. All courses are offered as Hybrid now, with the exception of Crafts I and Three-Dimensional Art, which are in person only. Enrollment in the program has been steadily increasing.

3. The Fine Arts program held three art Shows in the Spring of 2024, including the North Dakota Universities Traveling Art Exhibit.

Current Program Goals 2023-24

1. The Fine Arts program will look for outreach opportunities to increase enrollment in the program.
