Program Highlights 2023-24

1. Persistence increased by 11% between FA 22 and SP 24

2. There was a 5% increase between FA 22 and FA 23 in total term credits completed

3. Full time fall enrollment jumped by 24% between FA 22 and FA 23

Current Program Goals 2023-24

[as reported on the Fall 2023 Program Goal Status Report]

1. Continue to increase student retention and persistence of Liberal Arts students. Monitor student credit hour load compared to student success and persistence.

2. Create an "Introduction to Liberal Arts" video discussing what liberal arts is and why it is important. Use as a form of outreach.

3. All Liberal Arts Faculty will revise the institutional rubric to fit their course and use the rubric for a writing assignment.

Progress on Current Program Goals 2023-24

1. Persistence increased by 11% between FA 22 and SP 24.

3. Faculty are using an institutional rubric in assignments.

Updated/Revised Program Goals for 2024-25

1. Shorten the developmental math sequence in the traditional algebraic math pathway with a condensed course to reduce student time spent in developmental math from 3 semesters down to 2 semesters.

3. Continue to increase student persistence, but make additional efforts to increase retention. Increase degree completion and transfer rates for terminal degrees.
