Program Highlights 2023-24

- 1. 19 graduates now hold a bachelor's degree from UND. More graduating in May of 2024.
- 2. More students are attending UND and more have been admitted to the social work program at UND. Both bachelor's and master's.
- 3. Public Service Announcement (PSA) from 13 students reflecting on coming to CCCC. Galynn Lindemann was a guest speaker at the Dream 2024 conference in Orlando, FL showcasing the success of the paid internship program for social work at CCCC.

Current Program Goals 2023-24

- 1. Continue to expand enrollment area and grow the program and completion. Continue to be interactive within the community and develop solutions whenever possible. For example: Wana Wota (food pantry), coat drive, PSA's. Continue to grow the internship agency list which now includes over 40 agencies.
- 2. Continue 2 + 2 relationship with UND and Lake Region State College. Monitor student success and transfer to UND in the social work program. Continue to pursue an additional 2 + 2 option with University of Mary. Planning and consideration of inclusion of TED talks or U-Tube videos to enhance the curriculum. Continued to work with American Red Cross to form an Emergency Response Team in Native American areas.
- 3. Continue online instruction. Continue using the college rubric grading system.

Progress on Current Program Goals 2023-24

- 1. Continued to work with American Red Cross to form an Emergency Response Team in Native American areas.
- 2. Continue to grow the internship agency list which now includes over 40 agencies. Maintain relationships with the various agencies where students can complete their 40-hour internship.
- 3. Updated the MOU with Lake Region State College. Completed MOU with University of Minot and are pursing the 2+2 option with University of Mary. Included various TED talks.
