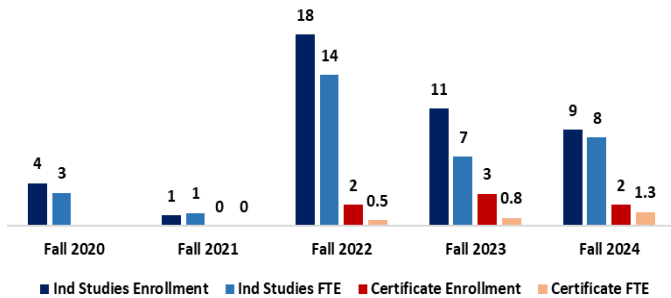

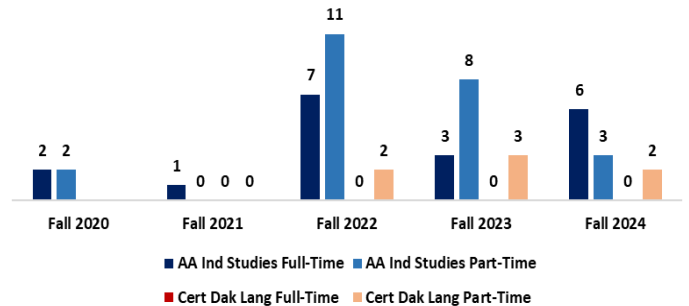

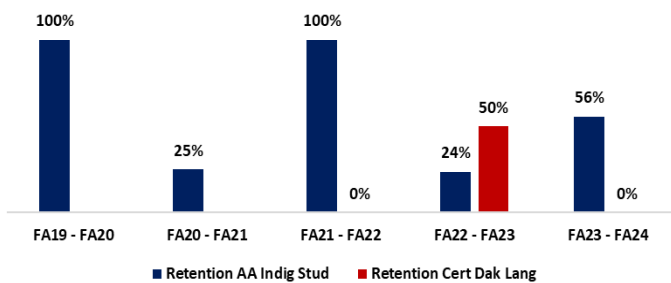

Fall Term Enrollment and FTE**



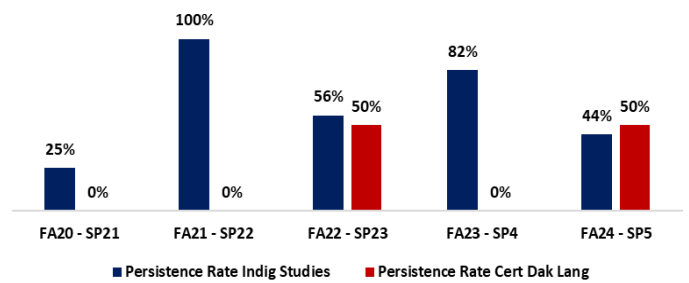
**AA Indigenous Studies

Fall Term Enrollment by Full-Time and Part-Time**



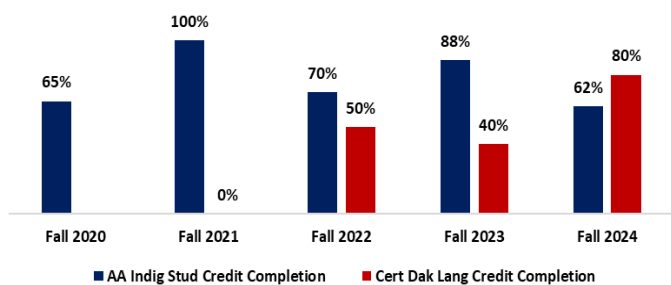

Fall to Fall Retention**



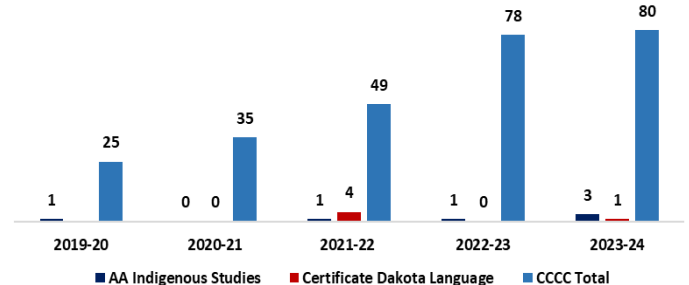
