

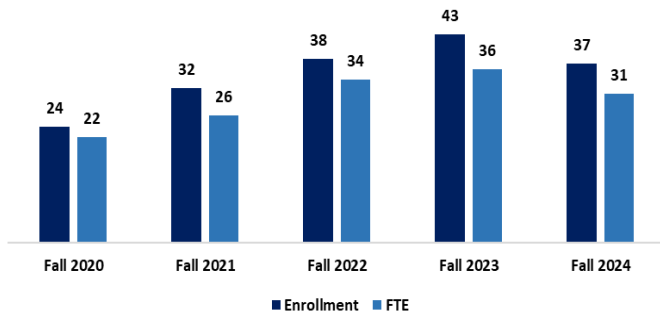

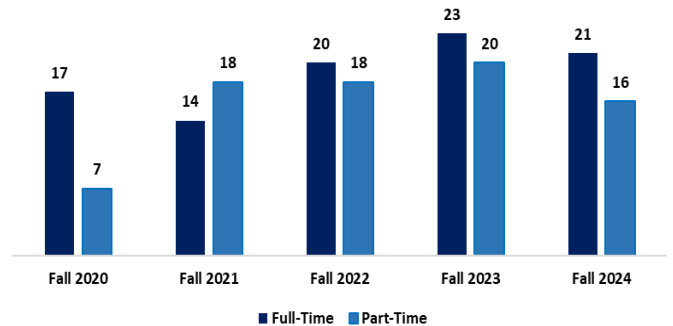

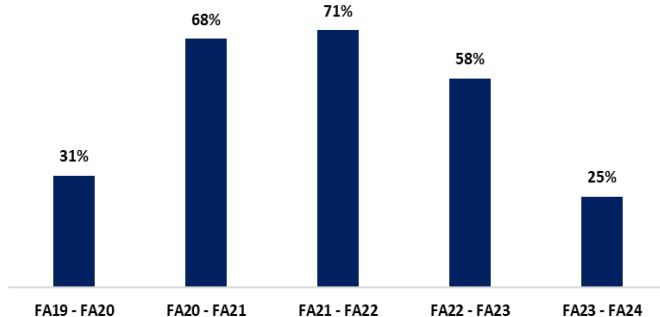
**AA Social Work**  
**Fall Term Enrollment and FTE**



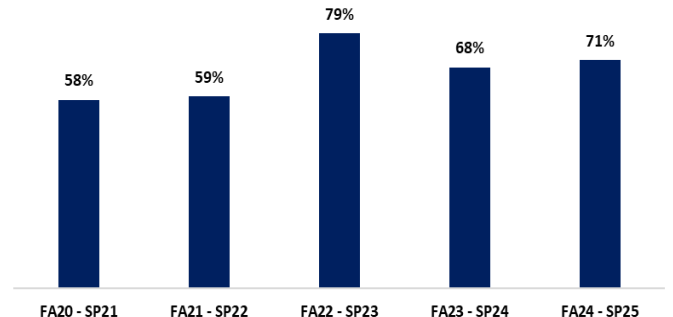
**AA Social Work**  
**Fall Term Enrollment by Full-Time and Part-Time**



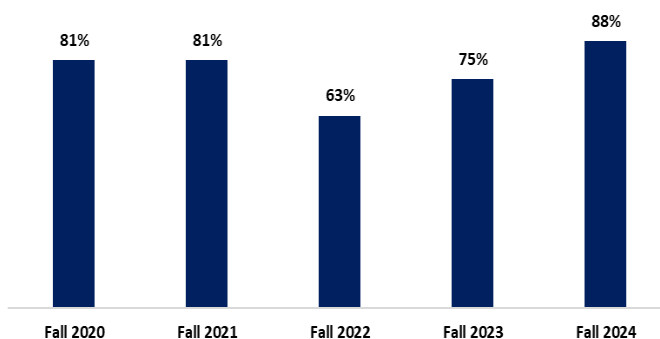
**AA Social Work**  
**Fall to Fall Retention**



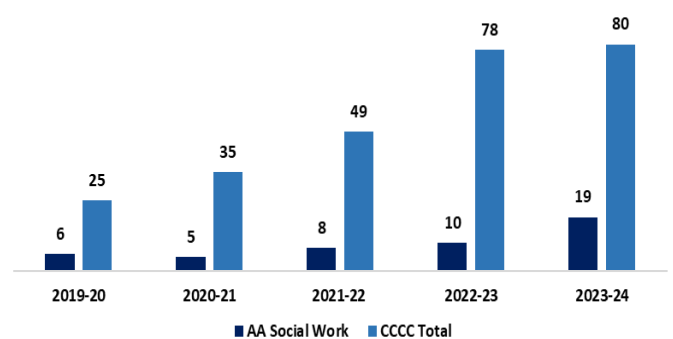
**AA Social Work**

## Program Highlights 2024-25

1. 26 graduates now hold a bachelor's degree in social work from UND. More graduating in May of 2025.

2 More students are attending UND and more have been admitted to the social work program at UND. Both bachelor's and master's level. Five are enrolled in the Master's program.

## Current Program Goals 2024-25

1. Expand social work apprenticeship program.

2. Increase student interest to pursue a Bachelor/Master of Social Work degree. Transfer speakers from colleges.

3. Strengthen crisis intervention abilities.

## Progress on Current Program Goals 2024-25

1. Expanded apprenticeship program, which now includes several social work students working with the Hess Grant. Grew internship agency list to now include 49 agencies. Maintain relationships with agencies

2. Relationship with UND is very strong. Speakers are still coming through ZOOM.

3. Crisis intervention skills has been put on hold as the funding has stopped from Red Cross

## Updated/Revised Program Goals for 2025-26

1. The social work program will begin working with First Nations Women's Alliance for Fall/Spring student internship opportunities which are instrumental to social work, allowing the student to receive first hand social work skills where application of classroom learning is applied. The projected timeline for Fall 2025 is for three students and for Spring 2026 two students

2. The projected social work department goal is to increase enrollment in the social work program for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 by five students

3. The proposed goal is to increase students transferring to a university to complete their academic journey. The projected timeline for fall 2025 is to increase transfers by three students for spring of 2026 increase transfers by three students
