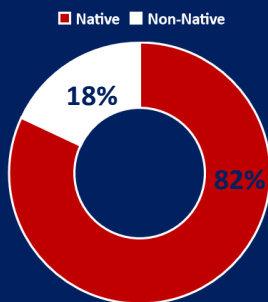

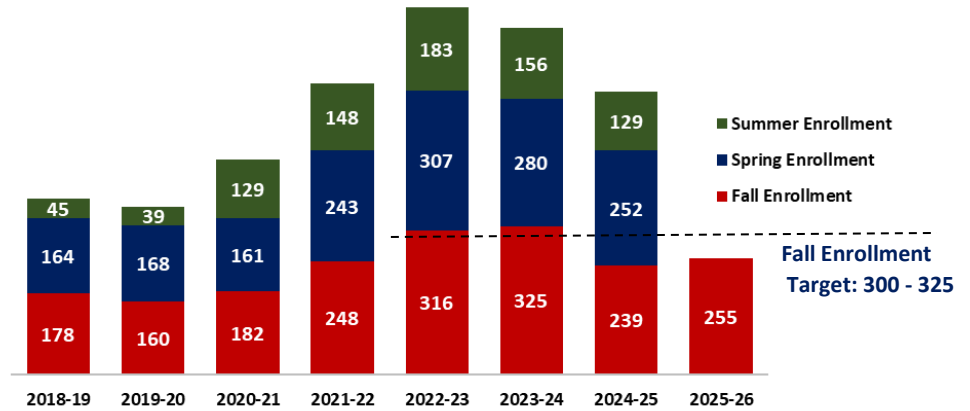

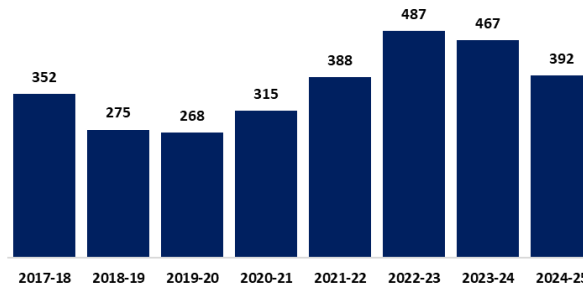

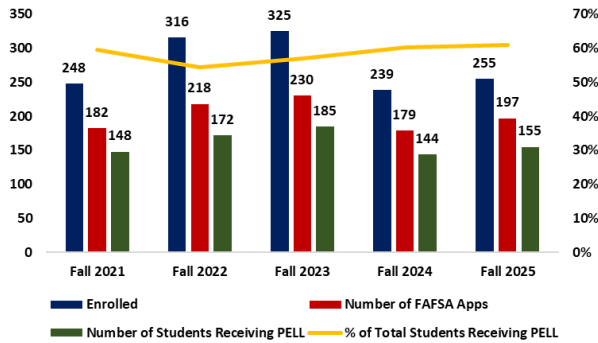

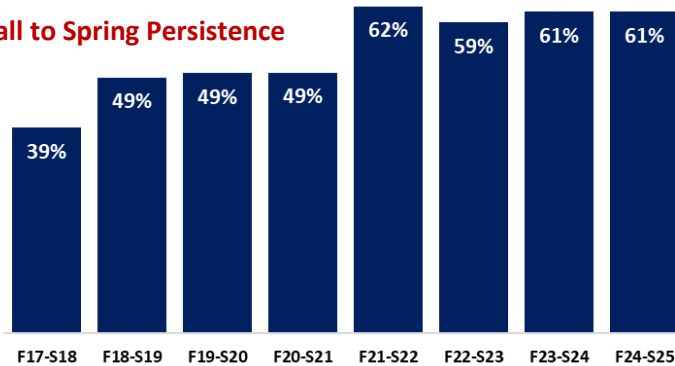


For the 2024-25 academic year, CCCC students received over \$1.7 million in scholarships and aid

Student Outcomes and Measures

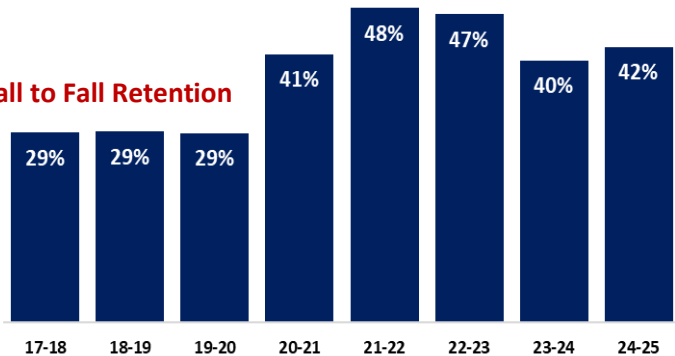
Fall to Spring Persistence

Fall to Fall Retention

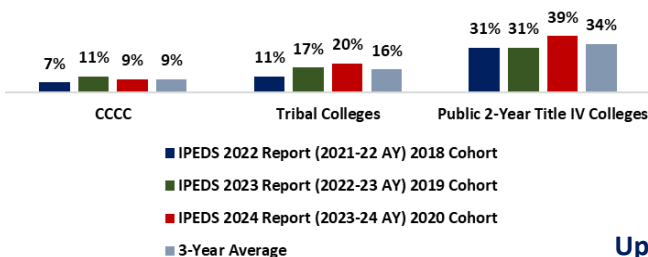


CCCC Retention Goal: >50%
