



Spirit Lake Tribe Enrollment and Age









Spirit Lake Tribe Labor Force Data






Poverty Rate and Median Household Income








On-time graduation rate based upon high school students obtaining a diploma within four years of entering 9th grade




Percentage of high school seniors completing a high school diploma (includes previous dropouts obtaining a GED before age 22)



Percent of adults 25 and older having attained a high school diploma 2023





Percent of residents 25 and older with a bachelor's degree or higher 2023

Total Fall Enrollment and Full-Time Equivalent




Fall Enrollment/Native American Enrollment



















Fall Enrollment by Full Time/Part Time

Part Time = student taking less than 12 credits




Students in their first semester of college at CCCC including high school students enrolled in dual-credit/early entry courses in their first semester; includes transfer students in their first semester at CCCC





Students Submitting the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and receiving PELL (federal needs based grants)





Students successfully completing a minimum of 67% of attempted credits for the semester with a semester grade point average of at least 2.0 (grade of C or higher)






Retention Rates

Percent of All Fall Students Returning the Following Fall Semester (excluding graduates)







Percent of All Fall Students Returning the Next Spring Semester (excludes fall graduates)





Graduation Rates





Course Success Rates


Percent total courses taken resulting in a C grade or higher including satisfactory (S) and passing (P) grades






