3. Have begun work on aligning course work to course and program outcomes as well as institutional outcomes.

Current Program Goals 2025-26

1. Maintain, over the academic year of 25-26, the number of ECE students at the three-year average of 37.

2. By the end of the 2026- 2027 academic year, the annual number of graduating ECE students will increase to reflect 25% of the students enrolled in the program.

3. By the end of the Spring 2026 semester, each ECE course will have 13 out of 15 zoom sessions enhanced to increase student engagement through the use of chats, polls, whiteboards, etc.
