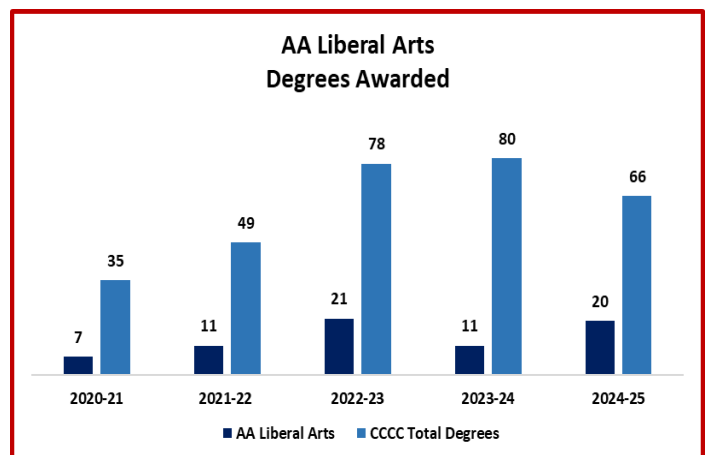
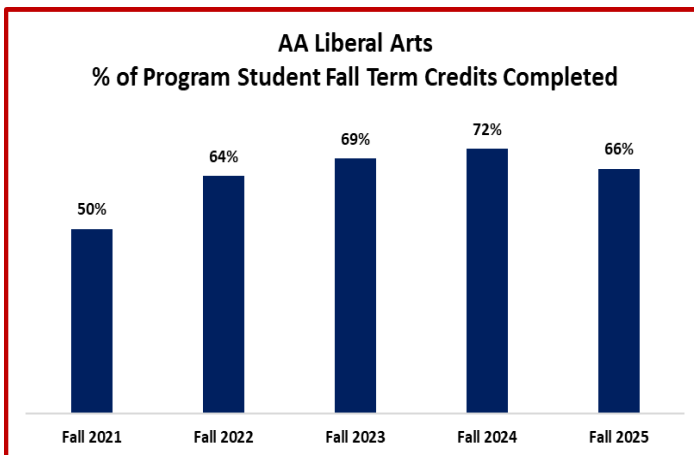
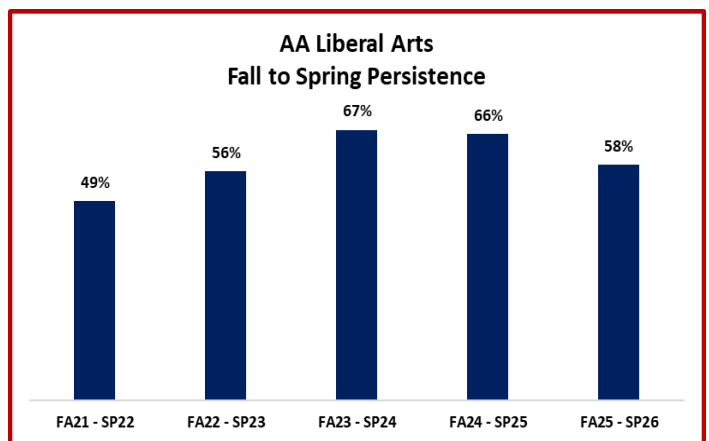
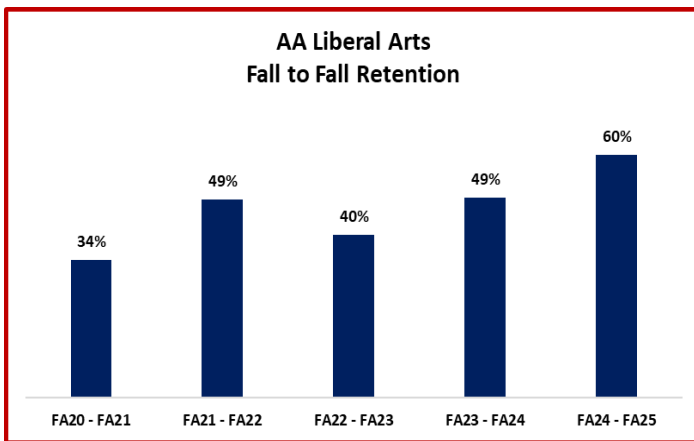
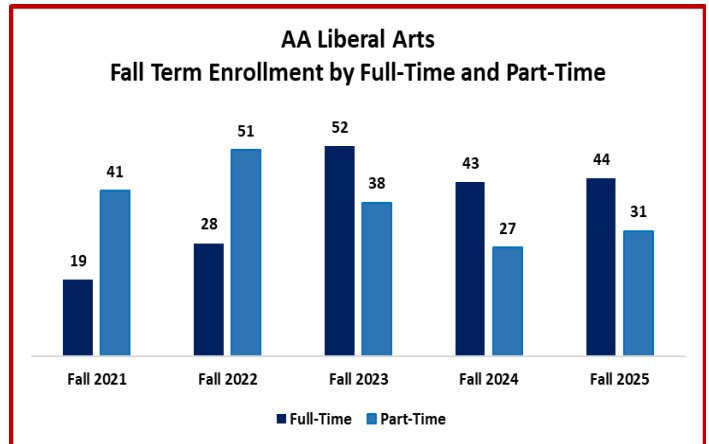
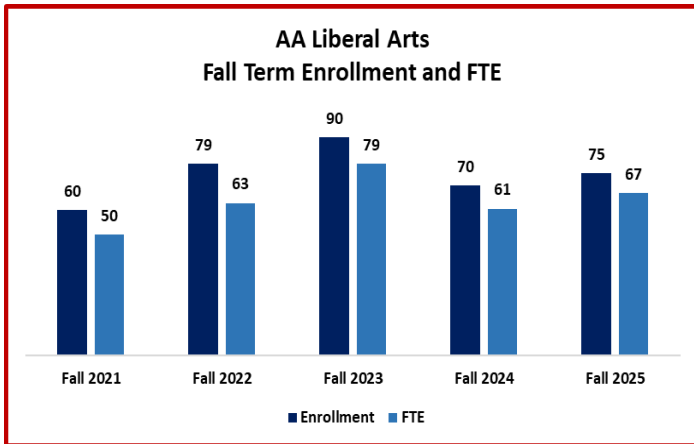




Spring 2026 Annual Program Snapshot

Program Highlights 2025-26

1. The Liberal Arts program increased retention of students from 49% to 60%.

2. The Liberal Arts program has maintained increased credit courses completed since Fall of 2022.

3. The Liberal Arts program has increased faculty, both full time and adjunct.

Current Program Goals 2025-26

[as reported on the Fall 2025 Program Goal Status Report]

1. Hold a critical-thinking workshop for instructors by Fall Semester 2026.

2. Liberal Arts faculty will update their course assessments before Fall Semester 2026.

3. Each liberal arts faculty will develop a course map for one of their courses by fall 2025, developing course maps for remaining liberal arts courses by spring, 2026.

Progress on Current Program Goals 2025-26

1. The critical-thinking workshop planning is still in progress.

2. Liberal Arts faculty have updated their assessments, and it will be reported at the end of the Spring Semester.

3. The Liberal Arts committee reminded faculty that the course maps need to be completed by May, 2026. A template was shared for guidance.

Updated/Revised Program Goals for 2026-27

1. The critical-thinking workshop will be held for faculty by fall, 2026.

2. Liberal Arts faculty will provide training to other faculty on how to complete a course map by fall, 2026.

3. Consider at least six STEM labs to be held in-person rather than online by fall, 2026.
