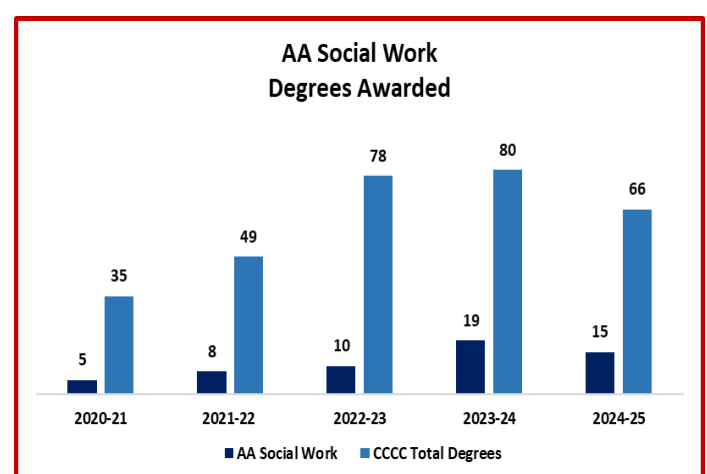
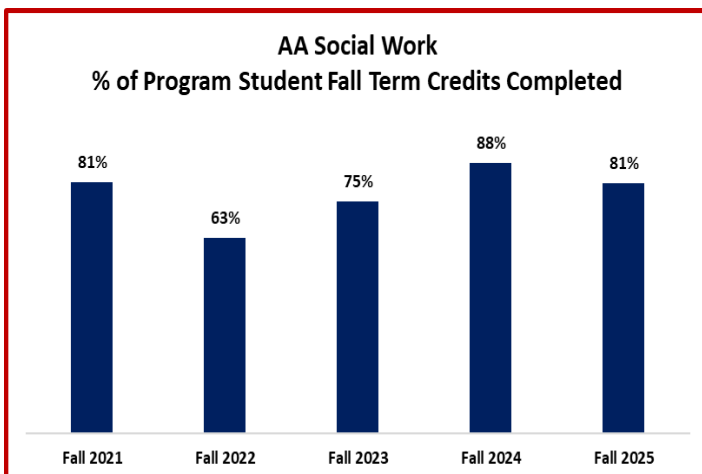
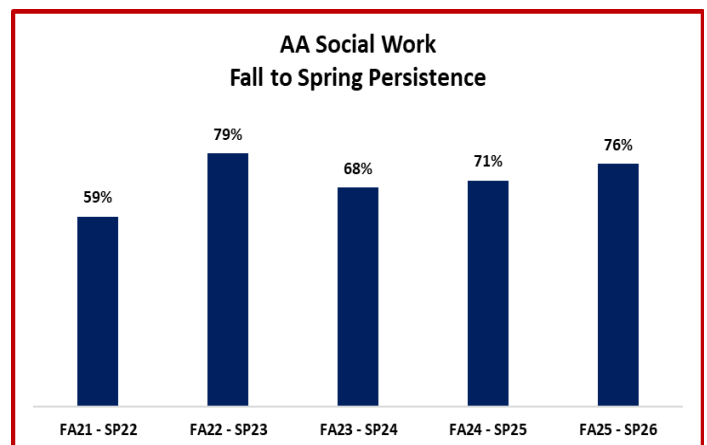
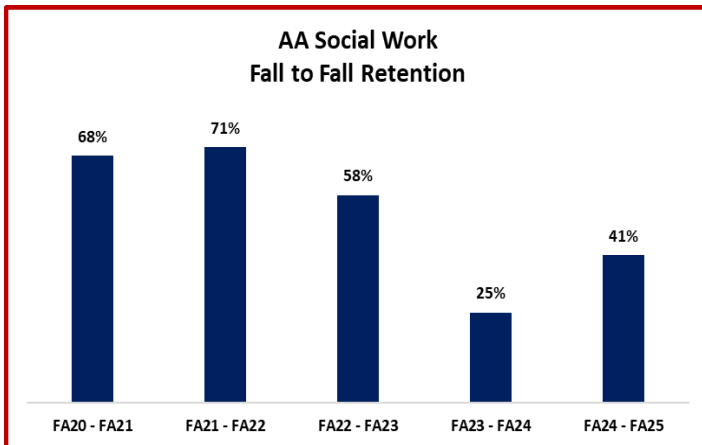
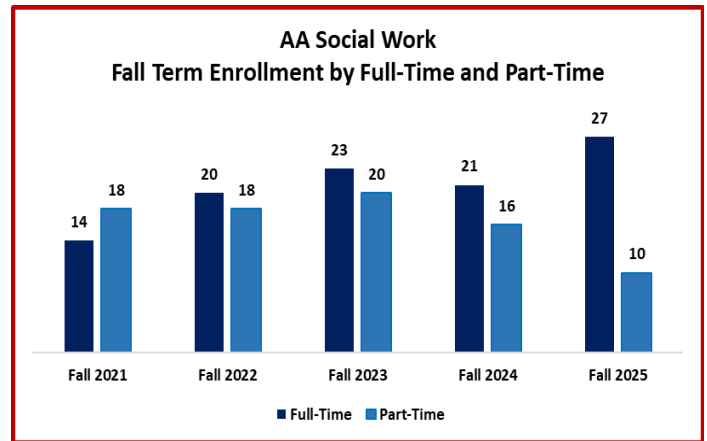
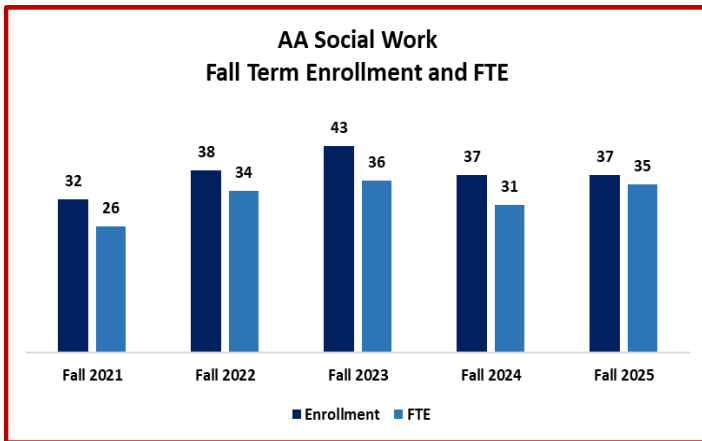




Spring 2026 Annual Program Snapshot

Program Highlights 2025-26

1. 15 graduates received their AA degree in social work from CCCC in May's 2025 ceremony. Many transferring on to a BSW degree or getting jobs that start at more than \$25.00 per hour.

Current Program Goals 2025-26

[as reported on the Fall 2025 Program Goal Status Report]

1. The social work program *will continue working* with First Nations Women's Alliance for Fall/Spring student internship opportunities which are instrumental to social work, allowing the student to receive first hand social work skills where application of classroom learning is applied. The projected timeline for Fall 2025 is for three students and for Spring 2026 two students.

2. The projected social work department goal is to increase enrollment in the social work program for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 by *five more* students.

3. The proposed goal is to increase students transferring to a university to complete their academic journey. The projected timeline for fall 2025 is to increase transfers by three students for spring of 2026 increase transfers by three students.

Progress on Current Program Goals 2025-26

1. Social work is continuing to work with First Nations Women's Alliance: The representative has attended twice; once in Spring--17 students attended that session and once in Fall--21 students attended that session, interest is low from students---no known students have signed up for this opportunity.

2. In May of 2025 enrollment in the social work program was 37 in the graduation ceremony 15 students graduated from the social work program. Enrollment remains strong at 43 this Spring.

3. The 2+2 MOU is now in effect with the University of Mary, where three students have applied: 2 at the master's level and one at the bachelor's level for the NAELP opportunity.

Updated/Revised Program Goals for 2026-27

1. Will include two speakers who have graduated from CCCC to speak about their educational journey.

2. Will continue to work to increase the transferring of students for terminal degrees to UND or U of Mary. Which will include 2 representatives one from each college to speak about the process in class. Dates to be determined by availability of the speakers.

3. Introduction to a critical incident analysis template to be used in Case Management outlining: Who was involved, what does it mean, how does it affect the parties involved, what is a recommended course of action in a case study.
